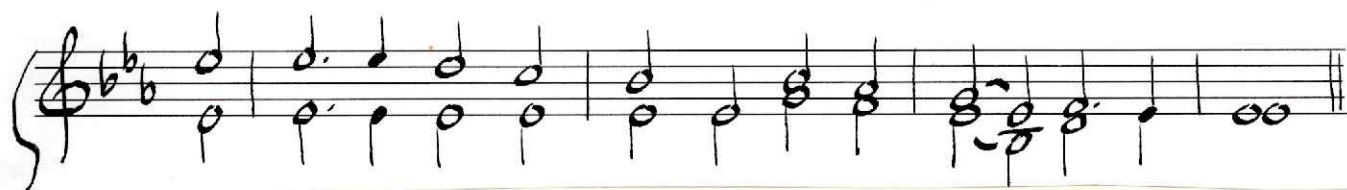

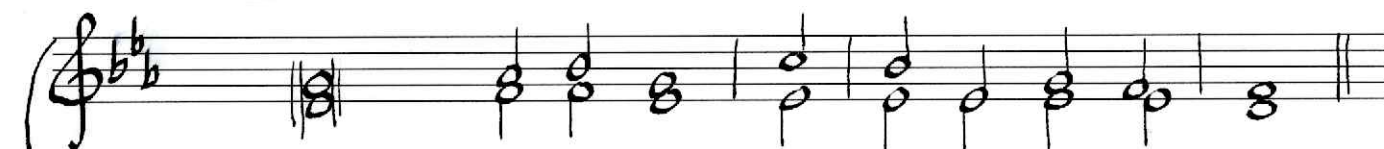
Hail, gladdening Light, glo - ry poured, who is the Fa - ther, Heavenly, Blest,

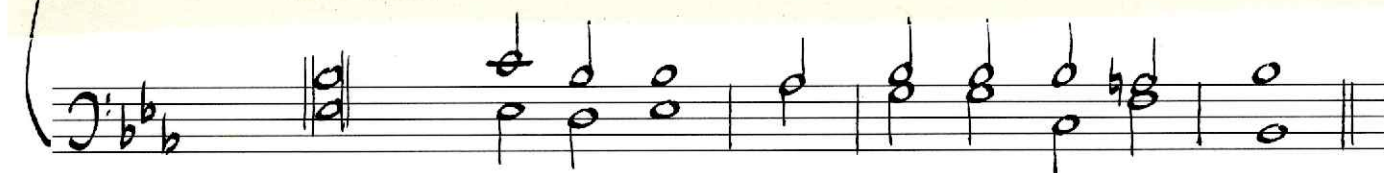
Now we are come hour of rest, the lights of eve - ning round us shine,

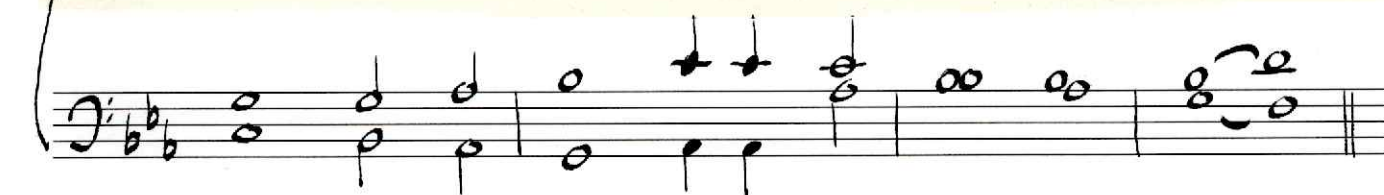
